UNDERGRADUATE (GENERIC & MATURE ENTRY) AND POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

The Malawi School of Government (MSG), an entity created through an Act of Parliament No. 33 of 2022, amalgamated the former Malawi Institute of Management (MIM) and the Staff Development Institute (SDI). Its operations commenced on 1st December 2022 and now comprise two main campuses: Kanengo (former MIM) and Mpemba (former SDI).

MSG is an institution that promotes Professionalism, Excellence, Innovation, Collaboration, and Inclusivity. It is now refocusing all its programmes to align with its mandate—to develop and deliver human resource development programmes and build the capacity of the public service and private sector.

	In addition, applicants are required to pass an entrance examination; the pass mark is 50%.

	b) MSCE (four (4) credits with two years of trackable experience in the relevant field).
